Saint Blaise – Blessing of Throats

Each February 3rd the Church commemorates Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr. According to tradition, Saint Blaise was a good bishop and worked very hard to improve the physical and spiritual health of his people. Legend has it that during a

persecution of Christians in the 4th century, as Blaise was being hauled off to prison, he miraculously kept a young boy who had a fish bone lodged in his mouth from choking to death. He is therefore considered as the Patron of Throats.

Confessions: At Saint Anne you may receive the sacrament on Tuesdays from 5:15 - 6:15 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 - 11:45 AM. You can visit Saint Winifred church where Reconciliation is scheduled on Saturdays from 4:45 - 5:15 PM.

Holy Eucharist is usually celebrated for the first time around age seven or eight and is preceded by First Confession (the Sacrament of Reconciliation). If you have a child who is of age, and currently enrolled in a CCD program, please make plans to attend a parent information meeting on Monday, February 10th at 5:00 PM in St. Winifred church.
