From the Pastor

February 2nd and 3rd - Two Meaningful Feast Days

TODAY the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, which commemorates the event when 40 days following His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple, in accordance with Jewish law. In essence, today's feast is a celebration of light, as Simeon proclaimed Jesus as "the light for revelation to the Gentiles" when He arrived at the Temple (cf. LK 2:32).

In practical terms, today's feast reminds us of the importance of offering ourselves to God and to always being open to His Will in our lives. In imitation of Mary and Joseph, we are called upon to present ourselves to God, seek His guidance and blessings, and offer to Him that which is most dear to us, our very lives.

At the 10:00 AM Mass, candles that we will use throughout the year for liturgical and devotional purposes will be blessed – candles that will remind us that Jesus Christ is the "Light of the World".

TOMORROW, some of those candles will be used for the traditional Throat Blessing ritual for the Feast of Saint Blaise. Blaise was a bishop and martyr who is known for his miraculous healings, particularly of throat ailments. His feast day reminds us of the power of prayer and the intercession of the saints in our lives – that through them we have access to God for our physical and spiritual well being.

The Blessing of Throats will take place tomorrow during the 8:00 AM Mass at Saint Anne's and the 8:45 AM Mass at South Hills Catholic Academy/Saint Winifred's. The blessing will also be offered from 12 noon until 12:30 PM in Saint Anne church.



New Seton LaSalle Blessed Sacrament Chapel

Last Tuesday I had the honor of representing our parish at a special Dedication Mass for the new Blessed Sacrament Chapel in Seton LaSalle Catholic High School. The chapel is beautiful, has been a long time in the making and will provide teachers and students with a fitting place to gather for Mass, weekly Adoration and private prayer.

Of course, the focal point of the new chapel is its tabernacle, where Our Lord resides in the Most Blessed Sacrament. I'm happy to share with you that the chapel's tabernacle was donated by our parish, along with matching altar candles and candelabra for Eucharistic Adoration. These items were used in Saint Anne church prior to our recent restoration, and I'm so happy they've found a new home where many of our younger parishioners attend high school.



Harkins Hall Update

I'm happy to report that the Harkins Hall renovation project is on schedule and due to be completed this May. While access is still off limits to parishioners, it has been nice for me to see how it's taking shape.

For future planning, I did want everyone to be aware that at some point in early April the upstairs accessible church restroom will be closed for reconstruction and the addition of the elevator access. Simultaneously, however, the new downstairs bathrooms will be open, but the elevator will not yet be functioning. So, if you're in need of an accessible restroom, this could be an issue for about a month, and you may want to consider worshipping at Saint Winifred's or a neighboring church during that time frame.

Grief Support For Loss to Addiction & Overdose

Cope with grief and loss while receiving support & encouragemant

One valuable lesson learned over the past few generations is that people with similar pain can be very good for each other. The expansive growth of AA is probably the largest example, but there are many others. Anyone that has ever lost a child knows how helpful others can be who have time spent in the club in which no one wants membership. Those who have lost a family member or friend because of an addiction have a uniqueness to their grief and thus far, not many groups have been created for this specific pain.

Addiction Recovery Ministry (ARM) is running a grief group for family members or friends who have lost a loved one because of overdose or addiction. Our discussion will be framed by the video *Among the Many*. We will strive to offer hope to anyone grieving such a tragic loss.
