From the Pastor

Lent Begins Ash Wednesday



The holy season of Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday. On this penitential day Catholics receive ashes on their foreheads as a powerful reminder of our mortality and our need for repentance.

The practice of marking believers with ashes has its roots in the Old Testament, where wearing sackcloth and ashes was a sign of sorrow and shame for sins (see Jonah 3:6 and Daniel 9:3). In the early Church, public penitents would cover themselves in ashes as they sought reconciliation, and by the 11th century the Church formalized this practice for everyone at the beginning of Lent, reminding us of our need to turn away from sin and believe in the Gospel.

As the priest or deacon imposes ashes in the sign of the cross, he says either, "Remember that you are dust, and unto dust you shall return" (Genesis 3:19), or "Repent, and believe in the Gospel" (Mark 1:15). This gesture calls us to humility, conversion and sacrifice as we begin the Lenten journey.

Here are some suggestions on how to make this Lent spiritually fruitful:

- **Commit to prayer everyday!** Consider the Rosary, attending a daily Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, or even a simple Morning Offering.
- **Practice Fasting with Purpose** Fasting and giving up something meaningful is all about detaching ourselves from anything that distracts us from God.
- **Almsgiving** Offer some real time, talent and money to a worthwhile charity or someone in need.
- **Go to Confession** It's one of the Sacraments given to us by Jesus Christ, and has its roots in Sacred Scripture. There is no good excuse not to go. Period!
- **Read the Bible** Consider trying to read a little bit of the Gospels everyday and get through all four of them before Easter. You'll be surprised how everything you've heard all these years fits together.
- **Learn More -** Attend one of the many Lenten Programs offered by the parish.
- **Simplify Your Life** Limit social media, TV and other habits to create some space for quiet, prayer and reflection. I promise, it won't kill you.

Fasting and Abstinence

Please note that Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are both days of *fasting and abstinence*. Each Friday of Lent is to be observed as a day of abstinence. The law of fasting allows only one full meal and two smaller ones with no food in between. The law of abstinence forbids the eating of any meat products.

The obligation of **abstinence** begins at age 14 and the law of **fasting** is binding on all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59. Additionally, all Catholics are encouraged to do acts of penance beyond those prescribed by the law. Further, it is the responsibility of parents to see to it that their children are educated in the authentic sense of penance and are encouraged to do acts of prayer, fasting and almsgiving throughout the Lenten season.

Annual Appeal

By now all registered parishioners should have received the letter and brochure for the Annual Diocesan Appeal that kicks in every year as Lent begins. Formerly known as the Parish Share Program, the Diocesan Appeal raises funds that support the ministries, programs and initiatives that take place on the diocesan level.

This year our parish's assessment for the appeal is \$178,521, and regardless of whether or not we raise the funds for the appeal, we still have to pay the assessment off before the end of the year. For the past several years this is the only area in parish finances where we've been lagging behind, forcing me to pay the assessment off from our operating fund and having to cut back in other areas. So, I humbly ask you to participate to whatever degree possible.

When I was away a couple weeks ago I saw this quote by Anne Frank on a sign and it struck me, and I believe it to be both timely and true: "No one has ever become poor by giving."


