

### **Annual Appeal**

By now all registered parishioners should have received the letter and brochure for the Annual Diocesan Appeal that kicks in every year as Lent begins. For the past several years this is the only area in parish finances where we've been lagging behind, forcing me to pay the assessment off from our operating fund and having to cut back in other areas. So, I humbly ask you to participate to whatever degree possible.




