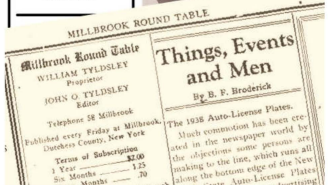
Jim Hanna has published a second book on the fascinating life of Bishop Bonaventure Broderick.

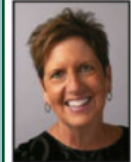
