
Safe Environment Workshop

Sacramental Information



Baptisms are celebrated on Sundays after the 10:00 AM Mass at Saint Anne church. Call the parish office at (412) 531-5964 to schedule. Completion of a Pre-Baptism class is required with your

first child before scheduling. Our next Baptism class will be held in January from 5:30-7:00 PM in the DePalma Room. If you have questions, or would like to register, contact Don Fontana at dfontana@stpaulofthecross.com.

Confessions: At Saint Anne you may receive the sacrament on Tuesdays from 5:15 - 6:15 PM and Saturdays from 11:00 - 11:45 AM. You can visit Saint Winifred church where Reconciliation is scheduled on Saturdays from 4:45 - 5:15 PM.

Holy Eucharist is usually celebrated for the first time around age seven or eight and is preceded by First Confession (the Sacrament of Reconciliation). If you have a child who is of age, be sure to enroll them in our Faith Formation (CCD) program at South Hills Catholic Academy. Call (412) 631-3131 for more information.

Weddings are scheduled on Saturdays at 1:30 PM in Saint Anne church. Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least six months in advance, and a Pre-Cana class is required. The class takes place on the first weekend of March (February 28 & March 1, 2025). Information about the class, as well as guidelines regarding wedding planning in our parish, is available on our website in the *Sacraments and Ceremonies* section.

If you or someone you know has recently become engaged to be married, they are invited to contact Fr. Mike to set up an

appointment to meet with him. Call the parish office (412) 531-5964.

Holy Orders is the call for men to share in the Priesthood for the salvation of souls. This call, or vocation, asks men to attend a seminary where they study and receive priestly formation.

Call (412) 631-3131 for more information. Time spent in catechesis and prayer is necessary for preparing for such a pivotal sacrament in the life of our teens.

For adults, Confirmation usually takes place as part of the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) and interested candidates should connect with the Parish Office to inquire.
