From the Pastor

Respect The Summer

On July 4, 2010 Pope Benedict XVI travelled to the town of Sulmona Italy to offer a Mass in honor of the 800th anniversary of the birth of Pope Celestine V. The life of Pope Celestine was remarkable because although he decided from a young age to live in solitude as a hermit, in 1294 he was elected to become the Pope. After a short while, however, Pope Celestine decided that he was not suited for the papal ministry and decided to abdicate his sacred office and return to the solitude of the hermitage. Interestingly, less than three years later, on February 11, 2013, Pope Benedict himself would announce that he would resign the papacy due to advanced age and the belief that he lacked the necessary vigor to meet the demands of his office.

In any event, during his 2010 homily in Sulmona, Pope Benedict extolled the virtues of Celestine and held up his example and lifestyle of solitude and interior silence as one for all of us to try and follow, at least a little bit. Pope Benedict stated:

...it is precisely in external silence, but above all in internal silence, that (Celestine) succeeded in perceiving God's voice, a voice that was able to guide his life.

In interior silence, in perceiving the Lord's presence (Celestine) developed a lively experience of the beauty of creation, the work of God's hands: he knew its deepest meaning, he respected its signs and rhythms, he used it for what is essential to life.

Benedict then went on to describe the benefits of cultivating such interior silence in our lives today:

We live in a society in which it seems that every space, every moment must be "filled" with initiatives, activity, sound; often there is not even time to listen and dialogue. Dear brothers and sisters, let us not be afraid to be silent outside and inside ourselves, so that we are able not only to perceive God's voice, but also the voice of the person next to us, the voice of others.

As summer begins, we must respect the opportunities that this time affords us to sit back, relax and reflect. Let us resist the temptation to have our children and ourselves always on the run from one activity to another. Because if we're honest, we'll admit that when we're always running somewhere, it probably means we're running away from something...



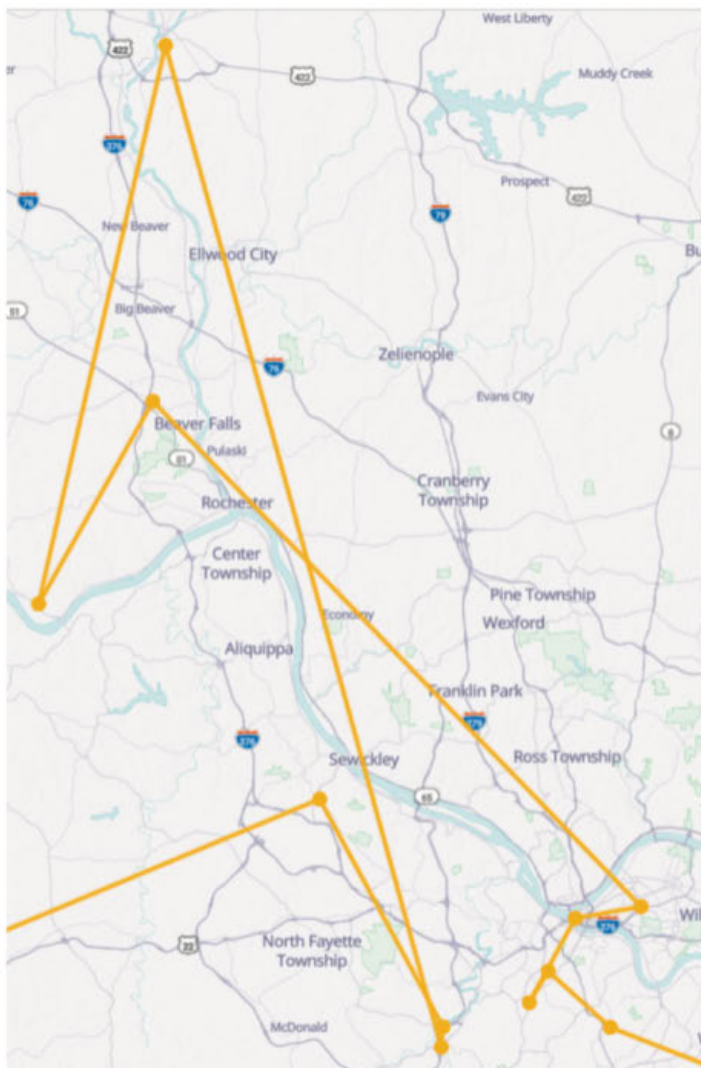
As we honor our fathers today, we are reminded by the Catholic Catechism that, "the Divine Fatherhood is the source of human fatherhood..." (cf. CCC #2214). Insofar as the Bible reveals God to be a Father, each Christian man must search for the truth of his identity in the fatherhood of God. And when we consider God as "father", we see that His fatherhood consists in being a faithful, strong and merciful leader and provider for the family of man. Let us pray today that the fathers in our midst will be strengthened in their resolve to strive for this ideal in a world so sorely in need of their faithful witness.

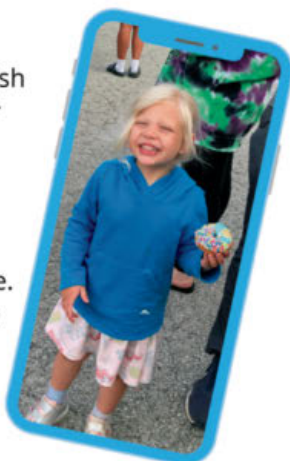
